1	Ricochets minimised?							
2	Hazards on path to target minimised?							
3	Are archers visible when moving from pegs to target?							
<i>The Target</i>								
1	Target suitable size for length of shot?							
2	Score zones clearly marked?							
3	Target and backstop secure?							
4	Backstop suitable and sufficient?							
5	Boss wood vertical (if applicable)							
6	Suitable and sufficient overshoot?							
7	Arrow search area safe?							
8	Path to next target clearly marked?
