ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enter this shoot you must have shot in a previous NFAS Champs (Scottish, 3D or National)
or enclose three shoot cards from NFAS open shoots.

You must shoot the style you enter on this form. Changes on the day will not be accepted.

2012 Membership cards MUST be shown to admin on signing in.

CLOSING DATE

Entries, with fees, to be received by Friday 23rd March 2012.

Entries received after this date will not be accepted.

SCORE CARDS

If you require your score cards at the end of the shoot, please provide a stamped SAE and
they will be posted to you. You will not be able to take score cards home on the day.

PATCHES

Scottish Champs Patches are available, by pre order only, at £4 each. Please state how many patches
you require on the entry form.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Members ONLY are allowed on course, including guests.
Dogs are allowed on site, but **MUST** be kept on a lead.
Catering will be available on both courses and at assembly.

Score Cards must be collected from Registration between 8.30am & 9.30am. Archers whose cards are not collected at close of registration will not be shooting that day. Only collect score cards for archers whom you are quite sure are on site and are intending to shoot. At the end of each day's shooting ALL cards must be handed in to admin, with the scores tallied, checked and put in the appropriate boxes.

All cards must be checked and signed by the scorer and the competitor.

Please return cards as promptly as possible .

DO NOT LEAVE THE SITE WITHOUT ENSURING THAT YOUR GROUP'S CARDS
HAVE BEEN HANDED IN.

Failure to observe Rules of Shooting, on-course coaching, changing of groups or other disruptive behaviour will render those involved liable to disqualification and removal from the course. Parents or shoot guardians of under 16s will be responsible for their safe and proper behaviour. We reserve the right to refuse entries from archers who failed to observe these rules at the previous years championships.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enter this shoot you must have shot in a previous NFAS Champs (Scottish, 3D or National) or enclose three shoot cards from NFAS open shoots. You must also shoot the style you enter on this form. Changes on the day will not be accepted. 2012 Membership cards **MUST** be shown to admin on signing in.

Directions to Parton

From the North: Take the M74 to Junction 15 (Signed Dumfries, Selkirk and Moffat) Turn right at the roundabout on to the A701 and continue on until you reach the roundabout at Dumfries bypass (A75). Then follow the directions from Dumfries.

From the South: Follow the M6 to Carlisle, continuing on the A74 to Gretna. Bear left onto the A75 (signed Dumfries and Stranraer). Follow the road to the roundabout at the A74. Then follow the directions from Dumfries.

From Dumfries: On reaching A75, follow the sign for Stranraer and travel on through Crocketford and Springholm.

At the roundabout outside Castle Douglas follow the by-pass towards Stranraer.

After approx 1mile turn right onto the A713 to Ayr.

Follow the A713 through Crossmichael. After approx. 4 miles you will arrive at Parton. On entering the village take the right fork at the village hall. The car-park will be signed from here.
