What's in these terms?

These terms tell you the rules for using our website www.nfas.net, WebBoard and any NFAS app (collectively known as "our site").

Who we are and how to contact us

Our site is operated by the NFAS and refers to the National Field Archery Society and NFAS Limited. The NFAS is a private members sports society company limited by guarantee.

By using our site you accept these terms

By using our site, you confirm that you accept these terms of use and that you agree to comply with them.

If you do not agree to these terms, you must not use our site.

We recommend that you print a copy of these terms for future reference.

We may make changes to these terms

We may make changes to our site

We may update and change our site from time to time to reflect changes to our rules, constitution, member's needs and our society as a whole.

We are continually looking to improve our systems to provide a more efficient service. As part of this process, it may be necessary to use information provided by our members for system testing. We will ensure that any testing is carried out in a secure and controlled environment.

We may suspend or withdraw our site

Our site is made available free of charge.

We do not guarantee that our site, or any content on it, will always be available or be uninterrupted. We may suspend or withdraw or restrict the availability of all or any part of our site for society and operational reasons. We will try to give you reasonable notice of any planned suspension or withdrawal.

You are also responsible for ensuring that all persons who access our site through your internet connection are aware of these terms of use and other applicable terms and condition, and that they comply with them.

Our site is only for users in the UK

Our site is directed to people residing in the United Kingdom. We do not represent that content available on or through our site is appropriate for use or available in other locations.

You must keep your log in details safe

Uploading content to our site

Which country's laws apply to any dispute?

If you are a member, please note that these terms of use, their subject matter and their formation, are governed by English law. You and we both agree that the courts of England and Wales will have exclusive jurisdiction except that if you are a resident of Northern Ireland you may also bring proceedings in Northern Ireland, and if you are a resident of Scotland, you may also bring proceedings in Scotland.

If you are a business, these terms of use, their subject matter and their formation (and any non-contractual disputes or claims) are governed by English law. We both agree to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
